I want to join First Baptist Church:

By Profession of Faith — Once a person has received Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, he or she is baptized by immersion. Both salvation and baptism are required for church membership. See page 667 in the hymnal for more information about how to become a Christian.

By Transfer of Letter — This means that a person is a member of another Baptist church (or another church of "like faith and order") and wants to move her membership from that church to this one. One must already be a Christian and have been baptized by immersion to do this. From which Church and Town?: _____

By Statement — This person was a Baptist, moved his membership to another denomination, and now wants to join First Baptist. The person is stating that he has been saved, that he was baptized after salvation by immersion, and has been a member of a Baptist church or one of "like faith".

By Rededication *and* Transfer or Statement. Sometimes Christians have been out of fellowship with God and out of church and want to renew their commitment. Church members may also re-dedicate their lives to God.

Watchcare Status — For those who want to receive information about the church program and enjoy the love and ministry of the church, but who aren't ready to meet the expectations of church membership. They may not vote in conference or hold an office. Just mark, complete, and return this form for Watchcare status.
