

Care Group Leaders: A Job Description

Overview

- Care Group Leaders are the backbone of the corps!
- You are in one-on-one ministry.
- You have approximately 5 people in your care group.
- Build positive relationships with your care group members.
- Set a positive example by living for Christ and being fully involved in the church.
- Contact your group members regularly.

Ministry

- Be alert to members with ministry needs.
- Communicate prayer concerns to the class Prayer Leader and Teacher.
- Contact the church staff when you need reinforcements.

Absentees & Backsliders

- Provide "reminder calls" to those that need them so they won't forget to attend.
- Be the "early warning detection" person for group members who are beginning to drop out or backslide.
- During class, check for absentees and make a note to call them Sunday afternoon.

Communication

- Be prepared to explain to Care Group Members what is going on when the church is having a special emphasis.

Multiplication

- Enlist an apprentice from the group as a helper and understudy.
